### How the time went

- 1998: **First commit** in BIRD history
- 2000: BIRD released as 1.0.0
- 2005: First dual-core CPUs available
- 2011: CZ.NIC starts maintaining BIRD
- 2017: First **16-core CPU**s available
- 2017: Integrating IPv4 code with IPv6
- 2018: Filter code heavily optimized
- 2022: Multithreaded BIRD 3.0-alpha0



### What is done and works

- New filter engine (since v2)
- Asynchronous route export
- BGP thread separation
- Non-blocking RPKI loading
- Pipe thread separation



## What is broken in 3.0-alpha0

- Calling ROA check from CLI
- Peak memory management
- Auxiliary Import / export table performance
- MRT dumps
- BMP, Flowspec validation (unmergeable)
